




**2020 LL & Xerographic** - 20lb vellum and 16-20lb vellum lines designed for use in laser printers. Available in unprinted sheets.



# OILS ACRYLICS WATERCOLOR SPRAY PAINT GOUACHE ENCAUSTICS

**TIPS:** Prime Clearprint® with a clear acrylic medium, like Grumbacher® Acrylic Medium and Varnish to seal the paper against linseed and other oils.

Taping and sizing the sheet will help to keep the paper flatter, especially when heavy amounts of media are used.

### **DRY MEDIA**

PASTELS CHALK

TIPS: Any dry media can be used with unprimed Clearprint® – a few coats of a final fixative spray is highly recommended on completed artwork as dry media has a tendency to be more delicate than wet media and particles have a tendency to smudge.

**TIPS:** Oil and rubber based inks should be used on primed Clearprint. 1000H can be used with an inkjet printer while 2020 LL should be used for laser printers.

**TIPS:** Vellum can be saturated with water or adhesives such as glue or acrylic medium, layered, sculpted, sanded or cut with ease.

## **TECHNIQUES**

### Layering

Translucent nature of Clearprint allows for layering multiple works.

#### **Dual Sided**

Artwork can be rendered on both sides of a sheet of Clearprint to create a single work that can be viewed from multiple sides.

### **Backlighting**

Lighting finalized works can dramatically change the appearance of artwork, and can enhance the transparency of the vellum.

### **Paper Stained Glass**

Heavy layers of paint become more opaque on Clearprint. The combination of thin and thick blocked applications creates a stained glass effect when lit. The addition of modeling paste piped around boarders enhances the stained glass effect.
